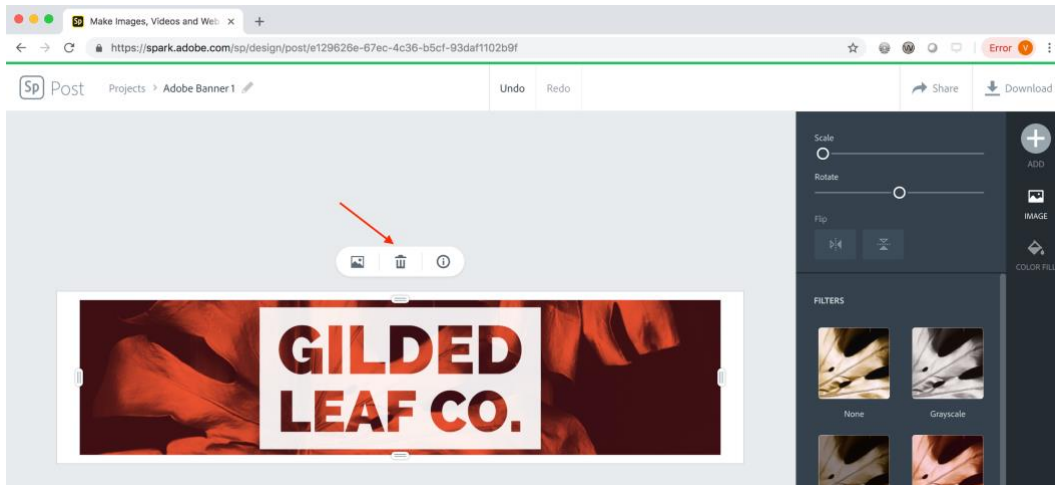
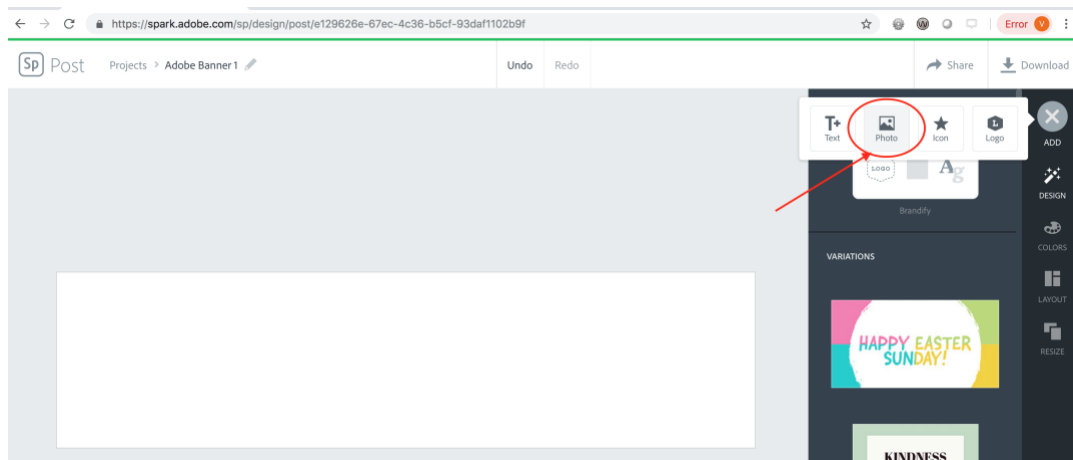


## The Second Task: Change Image and Text

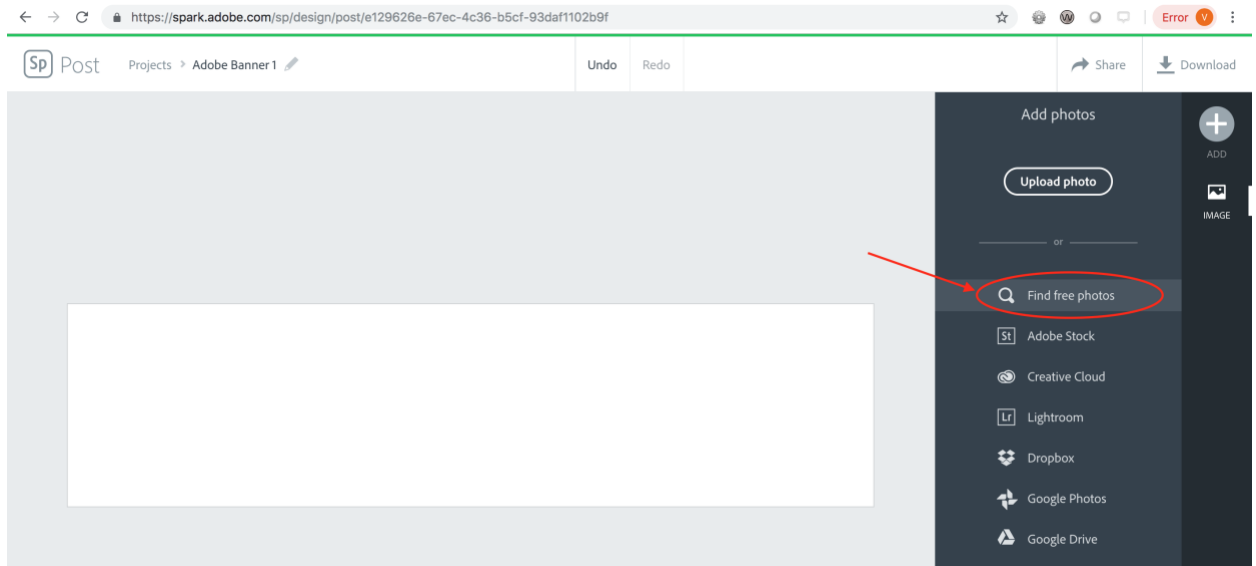
1. Now that we've chosen our design, let's change the image. Click on the **background photo**, and then click the **trash icon**. It'll look like you've lost everything because the project text is white (like the background), but don't worry, we'll get it back here in a second.



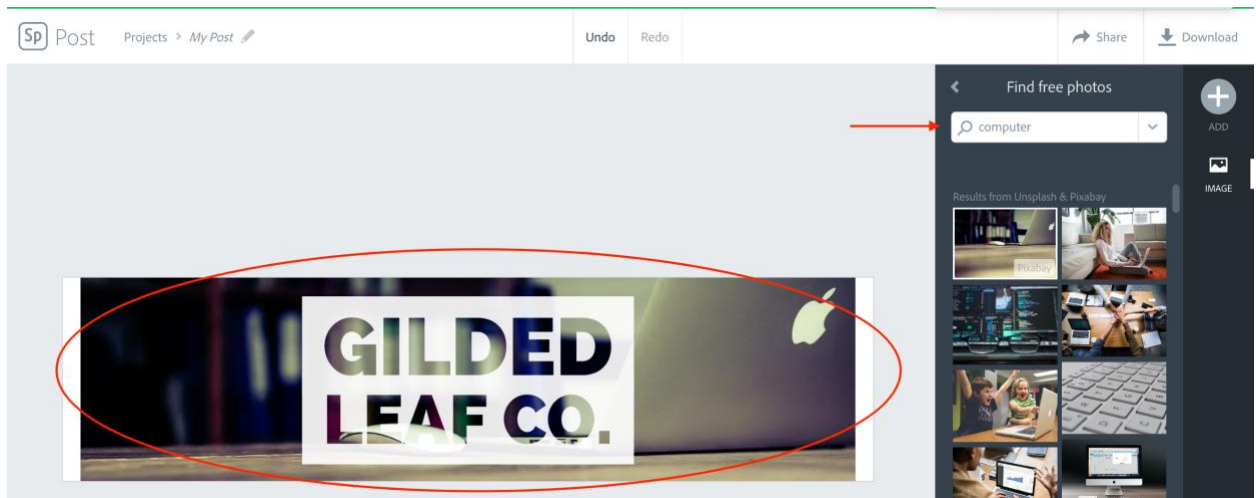
2. Next, click the **+ Add icon** on the right-hand side of your screen. This will open a menu that shows all the items you can add to your project: text, photo, icon, or logo. Let's add a new photo by clicking on **Photo**.



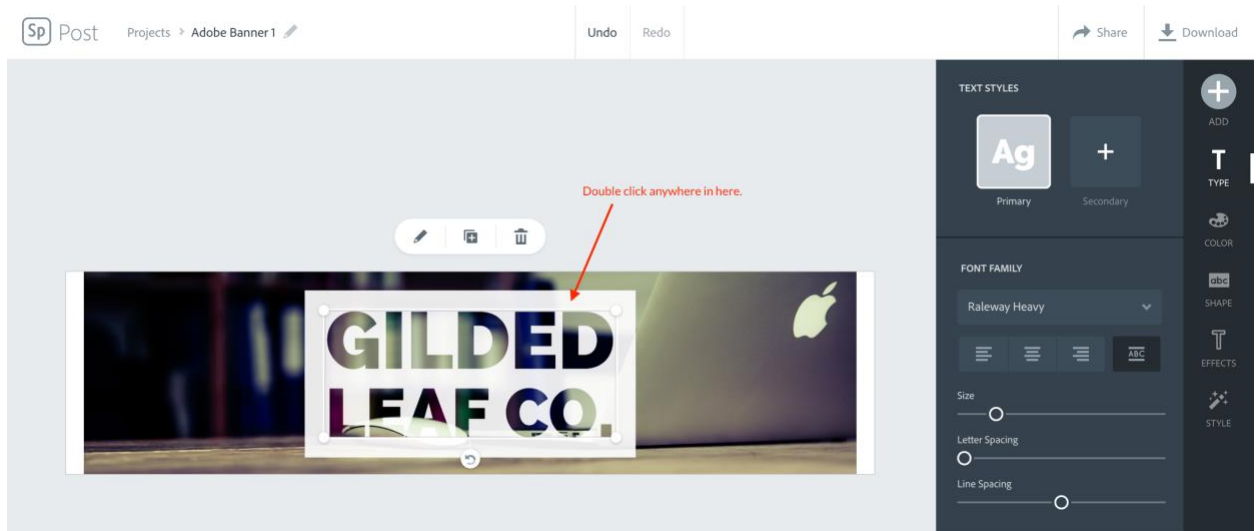
- Now, you'll see a menu that lists all the options you have for adding photos. Let's choose **Find Free Photos**.



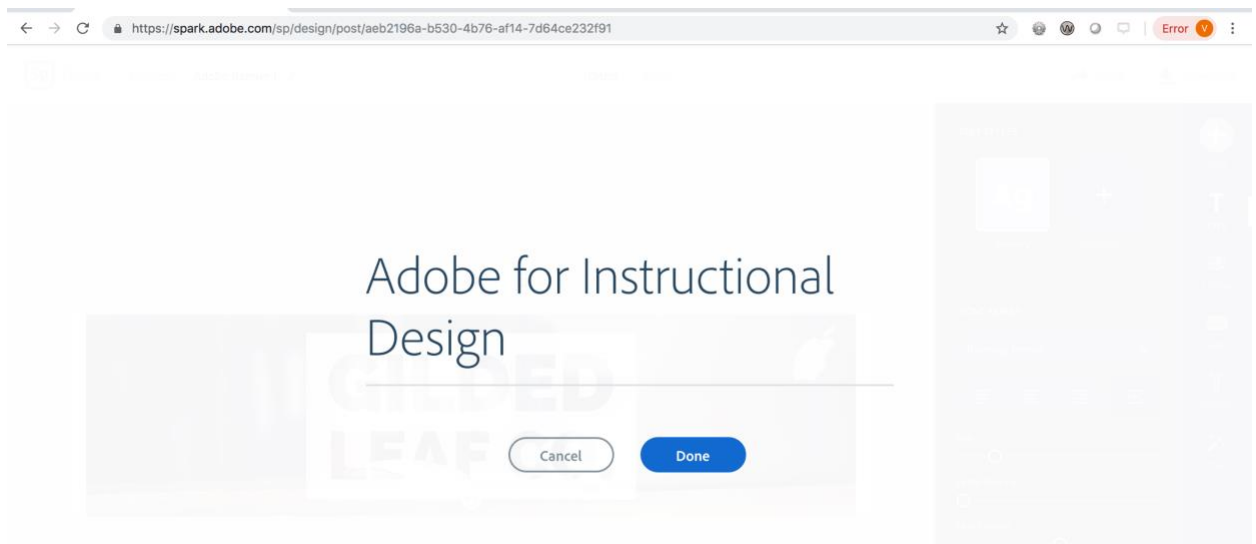
- This will open a search menu (Spark will search Creative Commons licensed photos, so you can use them without worrying about breaking copyright). Let's search for "computer." When we click on the first image, it automatically inserts it into our banner.



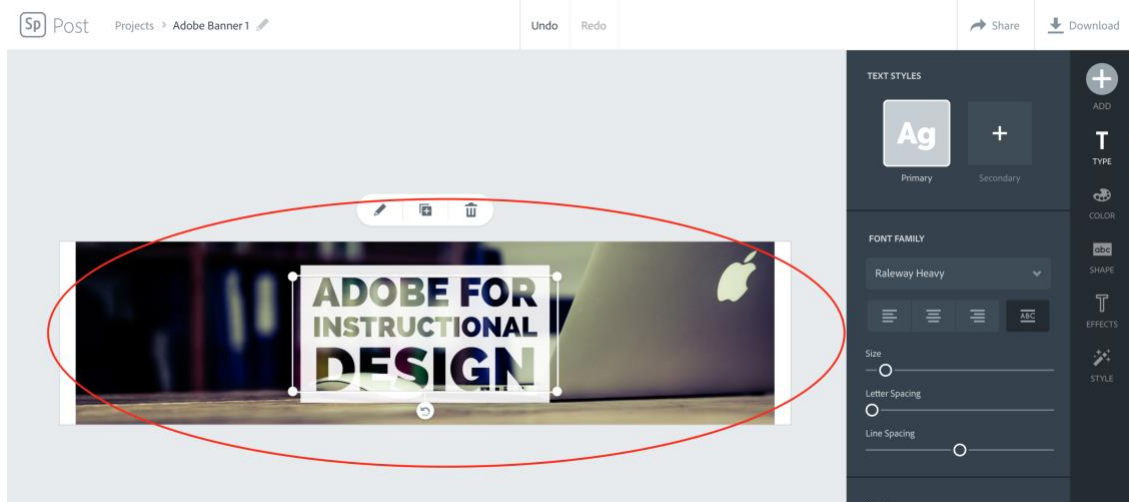
- Now, let's change our text. Double click on the "Gilded Leaf Co." text.



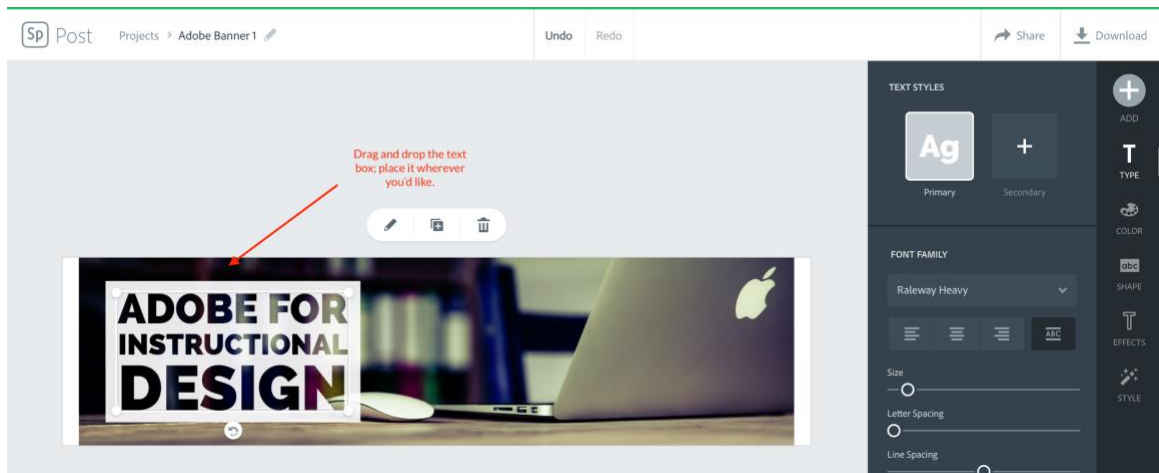
- This will open a screen where you can type your own text. When you're finished, click **Done**.



7. Once you click **Done**, you'll be able to see your new text inserted into your banner.



8. Lastly, we can move the text wherever we want on the image. So that it's more visible, let's move it to the left. Simply click on the text box and drag and drop it to the new place.
